We seek to fill a position for a doctoral/postdoctoral researcher at the Department of Neuropsychology, headed by Prof. Ullsperger. The department's research focuses on performance monitoring, flexible adaptive behavior, and decision making in humans and their impairment in mental or neuropsychological disorders.

#### **Requirements for the position:**

- Master's degree or equivalent in psychology, neuroscience, or a related field.
- Experience with cognitive/clinical neurosciences and methods (e.g., neuroimaging, EEG, MEG) as well as experimental programming and statistical data analyses is advantageous.

#### **Project Description**

The successful candidate will develop and conduct own research projects in the field of performance monitoring and/or decision making and supervise/co-supervise theses of undergraduate students. The position can be used to write a dissertation and obtain a PhD. It comes with a teaching duty of 2h/week (teaching language German or in exceptional cases English).

This position offers an excellent opportunity to work in one of Germany's leading imaging facilities. Research institutions in Magdeburg, such as the Otto-von-Guericke-University, the Leibniz-Institute for Neurobiology, and the German Center for Neuro-Degenerative Diseases, offer a great research environment and access to a multitude of research-dedicated MRI-scanners (3 and 7 T), an MEG system, and multiple EEG and psychophysiology laboratories.
